We are recruiting children to participate in a research study to learn if there are differences between the brain's connections in children *with* and *without* autism spectrum disorders (ASDs)

WHO:	Girls and boys with ASDs and children who do not have ASDs to participate as "comparison subjects"
WHAT:	Eligibility screening via parent phone interview, questionnaires completed by parent and school teachers, 2 days of computer games, paper & pencil tasks and an Electroencephalogram (EEG) test, IQ testing and report. Will require about 1 ½ days or 12 hours to complete all activities.
