RECREATIONAL THERAPY AT KENNEDY KRIEGER INSTITUTE

- Serves children to young adults on the inpatient rehabilitation unit with traumatic brain injuries, spinal cord injuries, chronic pain, feeding disorders, individuals recovering from orthopedic surgeries, and other complex medical conditions
- Provides leisure interventions to promote social, physical, cognitive, and emotional functioning
- Works closely with a multidisciplinary team (CL, PT, OT, SLP, NP, BP) to increase independence for each patient
