

MOBILE APP INSTRUCTIONS

We've developed a mobile app for Neurodiversity in the Workplace: A Collaborative National Conference, and it's now available for downloading! The app will be your source for all conference information.

Follow these steps to download and install the app on your mobile device:

1. **Download the Webex Events app:** Scan the QR code below to be taken directly to the downloading site for your device, or <u>download the app from the App Store or</u> <u>Google Play</u>.



2. **Sign in:** Open the app and enter the email address you used to register for the conference, or use one of the social sign-in options.

- a. If you choose to enter an email address, create a password and click on "Sign Up."
- b. If you use a social sign-in option, the email address for the social account you use must match the email address with which you registered for the conference.

3. **Complete your profile:** Fill in your networking profile, accept the terms of service and click on "Continue." Your profile information will help you connect with other people during the conference!

4. **Locate the event:** Search the event list for "Neurodiversity in the Workplace" or type it into the search bar. Once you've found it, tap on the name to enter the app.



Accessibility features offered in the web-based app:

- Adjustment options for content, color and orientation
- Pre-set profiles:
 - Seizure-safe profile: Reduces color and uses only clear flashes
 - **Profile for individuals with reduced vision:** Enhances visuals
 - ADHD-friendly profile: Offers fewer distractions to allow for better focusing
 - Cognitive disability profile: Assists with reading and focusing
 - Keyboard navigation (motor): Website includes on-screen keyboard
 - Screen reader profile for users who are blind: Optimizes website for screen readers
