My dream job is to be a pediatric occupational therapist who works with the autistic population.


I am a proud aunt, which sparked my love for helping kids grow.


A few of my favorite occupations include dancing, cooking, and hanging out with friends.

I have worked in the restaurant industry all through college.




- Capstone project: Program Development




