

Do you have a child with sickle cell disease between 8 and 12 years of age?

Researchers at the Kennedy Krieger Institute and the Johns Hopkins Hospital are looking for volunteers to participate in a research study on sickle cell disease and neurodevelopmental disorders.

To participate in the study, your child must:

- Be 8 to 12 years of age
- Have a diagnosis of sickle cell disease

This study involves 3 study visits involving:

- Neurological examination
- Neuropsychological testing
- MRI of the brain
- Blood sample completed at one of the visits above

After the 3 visits above, this study may require annual visits until age 12 years including neurological exam and blood sample collection. At their final visit at age 12, this study will require neurological examination, neuropsychological testing, MRI of the brain, and blood sample collection.
